To submit samples to the core facility for preparation and sequencing, please follow these steps:

1. Complete the WHCOHH service request

2. Provide sample ids and run id for each block of samples.

Download [excel file](#), complete columns A and B, save information as tab-delimited text and send it [Contact Information](#) by email to sequencer@mbi.edu

3. Bring your transformed colonies to the Core Facility

Colonies will be picked, templates prepared and sequenced, and results made available for download. Please arrange to pick up your plasmid templates if you wish to archive them.

4. You will be notified by email when you have results.
